



Ashton Vale to Temple Meads and Bristol City Centre Rapid Transit

An application has been made by Bristol City Council and North Somerset Council under the Transport and Works Act 1992 for an Order granting powers to build and operate a new rapid transit system. The system would operate between Long Ashton Park and Ride, Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol City Centre.
