## **Walking from Temple Meads railway station to The Council House**

There is a clearly marked walking route from Temple Meads railway station to the Centre Promenade in Bristol. Look out for our pedestrian signs and maps, with the striking blue strip, and follow the directions for the Centre Promenade. A walking map is also available from Temple Meads. ## **Car Parking**

There is no free visitor car parking at city centre council offices. There is a limited space pay and display [car park behind The Council House](#). You could also use the multi-storey [car park in Trenchard Street](#) . Visitor car parking is available in St Anne's House.

# **The Campus, Highlands Lane, Weston-super-Mare, BS24 7DX**

## **Location**

Due to the limited number of parking spaces outside The Campus, we recommend that visitors park in the nearby Superstore District Centre and walk to The Campus.

## **Directions to the Campus from The M5:**

1. Leave the M5 at Junction 21.
2. At the motorway roundabout take the first exit (if travelling north) or the third exit (if travelling south) onto the A370, signposted Weston-super-Mare. Stay on the dual carriageway.
3. At West Wick roundabout take the third exit onto Elmham Way (signposted Worle, Sand Bay) and stay in the left hand lane to enter the District Centre.
4. At the traffic lights turn left into the District Centre.
5. At the mini roundabout, take the second or third exits to park outside Boots or Matalan.
6. There is a footpath next to Boots which leads directly to The Campus.

## **Directions from Worle Railway Station**

1. From the railway station take the public footpath that will take you to Diamond Batch/Coast Resource Centre.
2. From Diamond Batch head straight across the roundabout into Elmham Way (pass willow sculptures on right).
3. Pass the Locking Castle Community Church (black glass windows) on your right into Bransby Way.
4. Once across the mini roundabout the Campus is directly in front of you.

## **If you require Disabled Parking**

There are a number of Disabled Parking spaces directly outside The Campus. To reach The Campus building, please follow the instructions above until you reach the District Centre.

1. After West Wick roundabout, stay in the middle lane and go straight ahead at the traffic lights.
2. At the mini roundabout, take the first exit onto Bransby Way.
3. At the next mini roundabout, take the first exit onto Highlands Lane.

The Campus is located on the right, opposite the Medical Centre.

# **The Winter Gardens, Royal Parade Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1AJ**

## **By Road**

Weston-super-Mare is just four miles from junction 21 of the M5 motorway. From the motorway exit follow signs to Weston-super-Mare along the dual carriageway link road (A370) until you reach the town centre. The Winter Gardens is clearly signposted as you reach the town centre, directing you along the sea front.

Parking is easy at The Winter Gardens with a choice of two car parks.

The Sovereign Centre indoor car park is adjacent to the venue with spaces available for up to 900 cars.

Just a few hundred yards up the sea front is the Melrose Car Park with parking spaces for up to 205 cars.

There is also a limited amount of free parking for conference organisers to drop off and load equipment. These will need to be reserved in advance of arrival with your event organiser.

## **By Rail**

Weston-super-Mare railway station is situated in the town centre just a few minutes walk or a short taxi ride from The Winter Gardens. There are direct services to and from London, the South West and the Midlands. For train times telephone 08457 48 49 50
