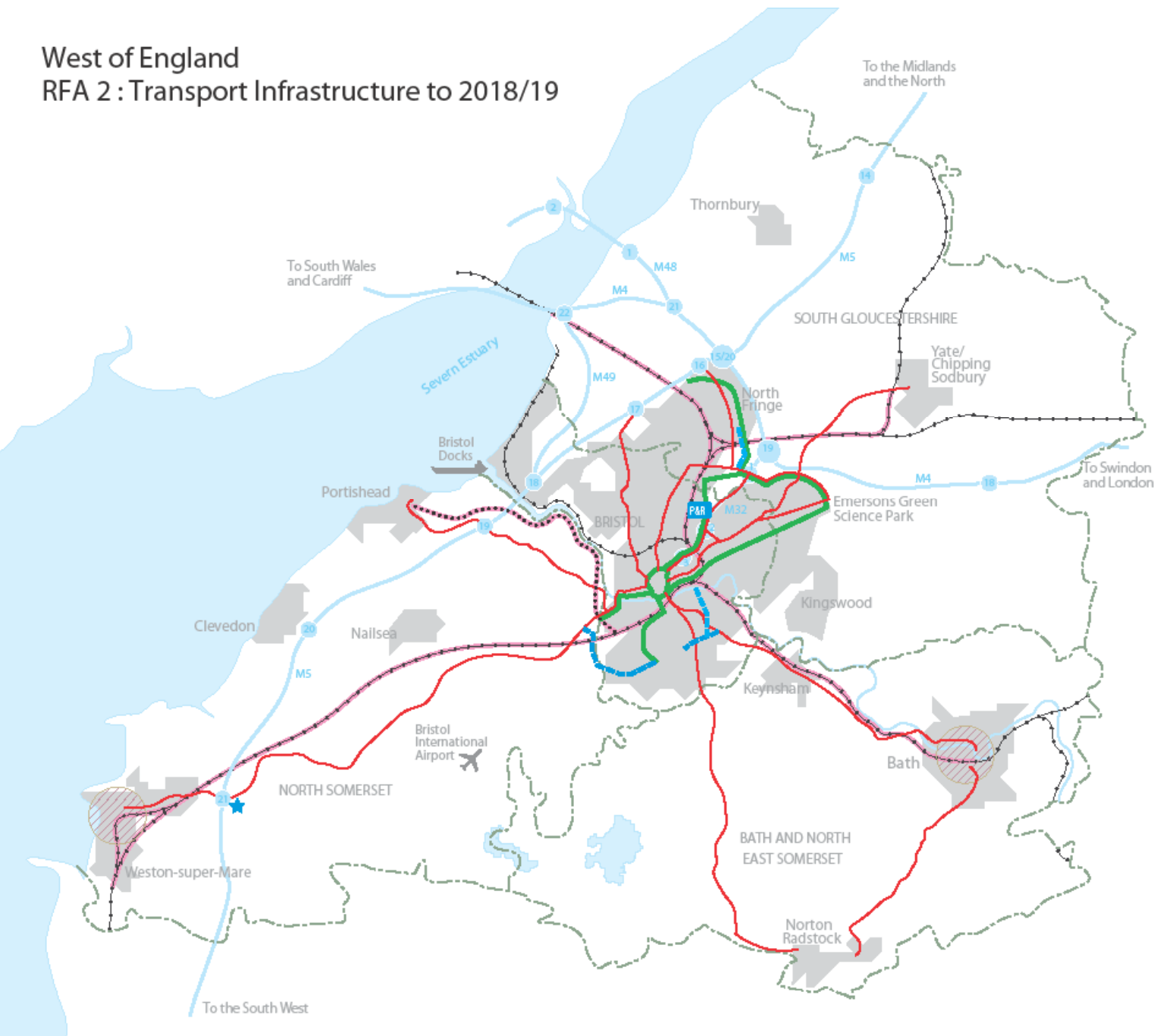
# The Importance of Place - LEP aspirations

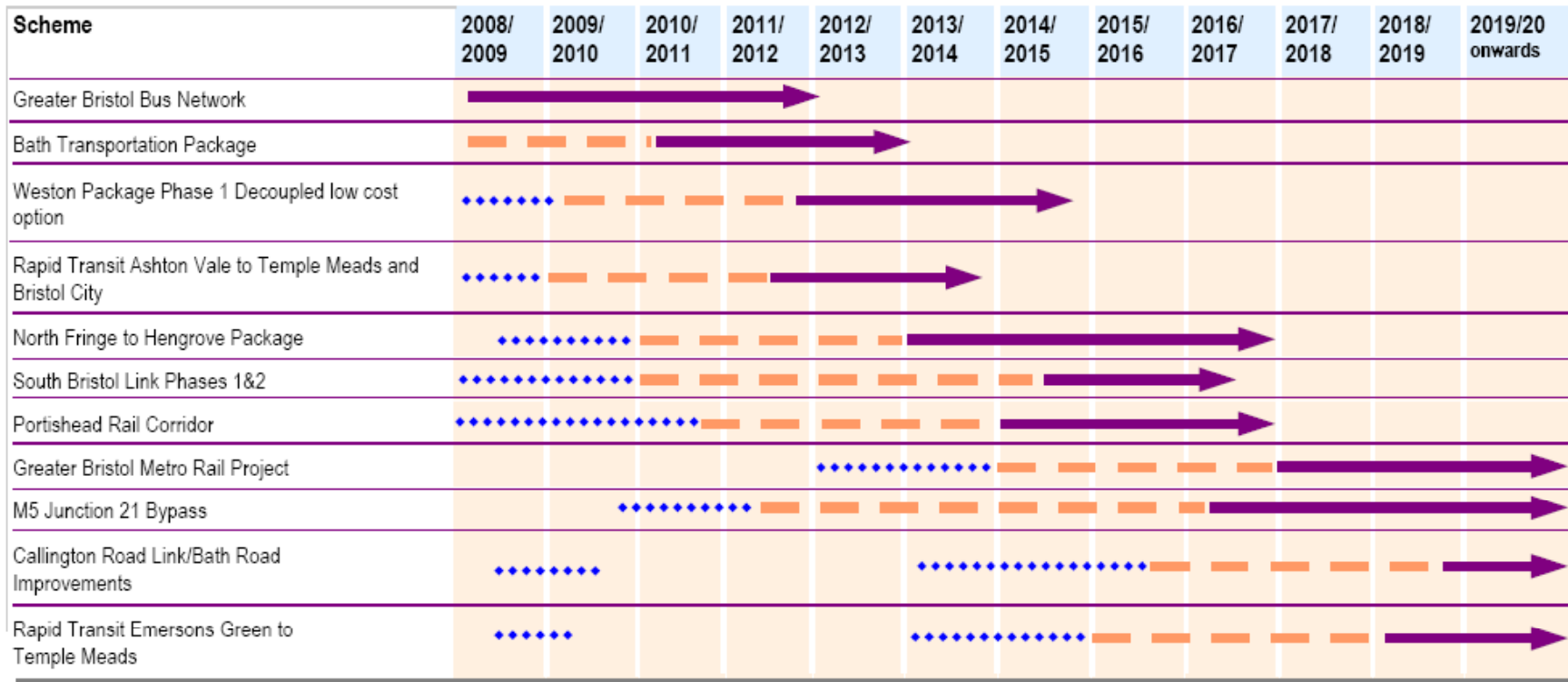
